TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE

These Terms and Conditions will govern any contract between Morgante s.r.l.soc.agr. (the "Company") and the customer ("Buyer") relative to the demand and supply of wine ("Goods"). Unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Company and the Purchaser, these Conditions supersede any other existing agreements. These Conditions shall apply to all sales made by the Company and any changes will have no effect unless otherwise specified in other written agreements and signed exclusively by the Company or members. Buyer declares not to have requested otherwise. These Conditions do not constitute an offer to sell.

1. PRICES AND AVAILABILITY

1.1 The prices mentioned in the most recent Company price list are exclusive of VAT and are subject to change by the Company without prior notice before the Company's acceptance of purchase by the Buyer.

1.2 The fulfillment of an order will be subject to availability and, if for any reason the request is greater than supply, the Company reserves the right to allocate the assets among its customers at its own discretion.

1.3 In the case where the Purchaser has sent an order for a product of a specific vintage and where the amount of product of that year is not sufficient to satisfy the order, the Company reserves the right to refuse the order or to satisfy it by proposing an alternate, more recent vintage, invoicing the Buyer the price of the product relative to that of the vintage proposed.

1.4 The Company reserves the right to decline acceptance of an order if such acceptance results in exceeding the credit limit granted to the Purchaser, or if there are outstanding invoices. Alternatively, the order can be accepted only upon pre-payment.

2. DELIVERY

2.1 Ex cellar.

2.2 Delivery dates proposed by the Company are approximate. If the Buyer does not specify any date of delivery, the delivery will be within a reasonable time from when the order is received by the Company. The Company agrees to make delivery at an address specified by the Purchaser, and the Company shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage resulting from deliveries made in accordance with this clause, including, but not limited to, losses or damages of any nature caused by or arising from late delivery.

2.3 The boxes of wine are placed on EPAL pallets, which must be returned at the time of delivery or the Buyer will be invoiced at cost.

3. WAREHOUSE AND DISPLAY

3.1 The Purchaser commits to store and present the Goods under appropriate conditions in order to preserve the quality and image of the Goods.

4. CONFORMING TO THE ORDERS AND COMPLAINTS

4.1 Upon delivery of the Goods, the Purchaser is obliged to immediately inspect the Goods to ensure that the quantity, quality, and their condition, corresponds to that stated on the delivery note. If the Goods do not correspond to the description, if they are missing or physically damaged, the Purchaser is obliged to note the discrepancy or damage on the delivery manifest and include a legible signature of the Buyer and of the carrier; or send to the Company and the carrier a registered letter containing a detailed description of the damage or discrepancy within 72 hours of delivery. These damaged goods must be retained by the Buyer to enable the Company or its agent to proceed to their inspection within the shortest possible time.

4.2 Complaints regarding any issue must be submitted in writing and sent to the Company within 8 days from the date of delivery of the Goods.

4.3 In the event that the Buyer has a complaint regarding the quality of the content of the Goods, the Company shall indemnify the Buyer only if they are returned to the Company with at least 2/3 of the contents remaining in the bottle and with the cork in its original condition within 7 days from the time which the existence of a problem was noted and the Company was notified about it in a timely manner.

5. PAYMENT

5.1 Prepayment of order.

5.2 The price for changes on back and front labels may vary according to costs.

5.3 Payment must be made in accordance with the commercial terms currently in use by the Company. In case of late payment, the Company reserves the right to suspend any future deliveries. In reference to commercial terms in use, if the payment remains outstanding, the Company may cancel the order without forfeiting its right to collect all amounts owed by Buyer.

6. APPLICABILITY OF THE LAWS AND VALIDITY; DEROGATION

6.1 This contract will be governed by and interpreted in accordance with Italian laws and is subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Court of Agrigento (Italy). If any provision of this agreement is void or unenforceable under applicable law, that clause will not be part of the Contract to the extent that its invalidity or unenforceability will not affect the enforceability of the remaining provisions of the Contract.

6.2 Any waiver by either party to object to any violation or breach of any provision of the Agreement by the other party will not be deemed a waiver to object to any subsequent breach or default and will not affect in any way the application of other provisions of the Contract.
